Casement windows open with a casement stay, if the window is hinged at the top of the window it is called an awning window and if the window is hinged at the bottom it is called a hopper. The window opens with a "Roto" crank mechanism, Heavy duty hardware options with corner drive and 150lbs rated hinges a lever or a handle that is positioned at the bottom of the window that makes it easier to access to turn to open the window. If the window opens out, it will be equipped with a crank, stay or friction hinge to keep the window steady in the wind. The glass in the frame is secured in a rabbeted frame and sealed with putty around the edges to provide and airtight seal in the compartment. In general, casement windows are rated as the lowest air leakage window on the market because they seal shut by pressing against the frame in comparison with sliding windows.
